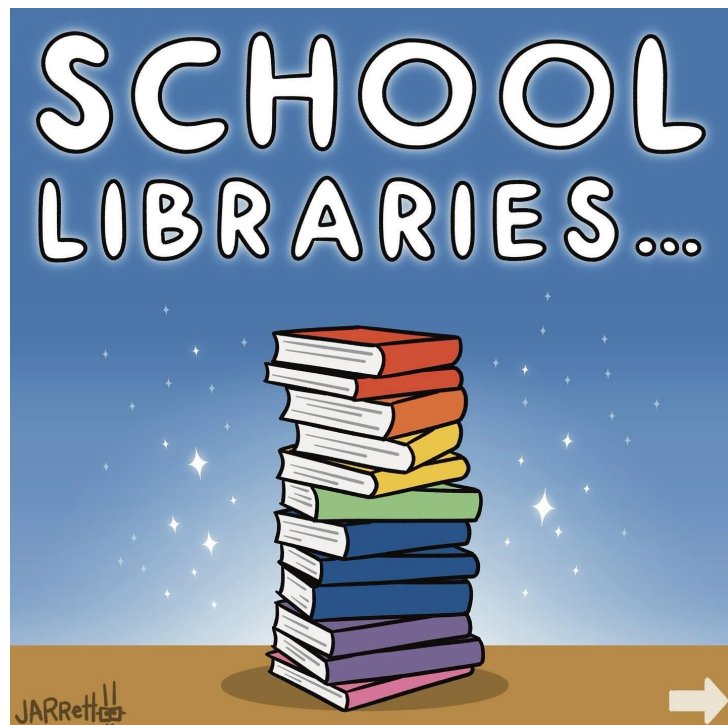

What Can I Borrow?

Prep and Year 1 students can borrow 1 book from the Junior Fiction/Junior Non-Fiction Sections.

Years 2 to 6 students can borrow 2 books from the Accelerated Reader, Junior Fiction, General Fiction, Non-Fiction or magazines at their teacher's discretion.

When Can I Borrow?

In Class—Students can borrow with their class in their timetabled 30 minute slot each week.

Students are welcome to return and borrow new books at any time during the week within library hours.

Library Hours—8.15am to 3.00pm daily

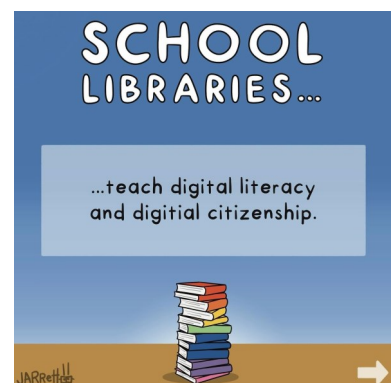
Years 3 to 6 can keep books to read over the vacation periods during the school year, but not the end of year vacation period.

All borrowing ends in Term 4 week 8 to enable stocktake and repairs to occur before the summer vacation.

How Can I Look After the Resources?

Library resources are the borrower's responsibility. It is advised that borrowed resources are kept in their homework satchel or library bag to protect them from damage and water bottle spills.

Lost and damaged books will be invoiced via the office to cover the cost of a replacement book. *Students will be unable to borrow if they have overdue/lost books until returned or paid for.*



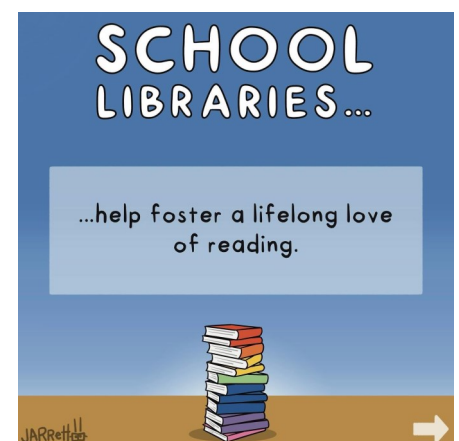
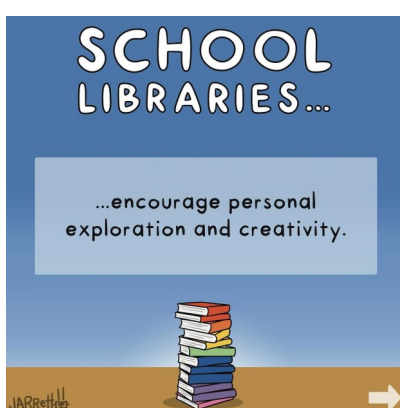
Lunchtime Activities

The library is open everyday at first break. First break is a rotating selection of games and activities.



Book Week

Each August our school celebrates reading during our annual Book Week event. This week includes special performances, lunchtime activities in the library and a costume parade for students in Prep to Year 4.



Pop-Up Library

Each week the school leaders set up our pop up library somewhere in the playground. This is a trolley full of books, pillows and blankets that allows students to enjoy reading in an outside location. Keep an eye out for it!

Our school participates in **Scholastic Book Club** each year. Twice a term, during the school year, we will send home a Club catalogue with a different selection of books offered for all ages.

You'll find award-winning books and bestsellers, as well as old and new favourites.

It is easy to order. The **Book Club LOOP** platform for parents allows you to pay by credit card. Your child's order is submitted directly to school safe and sound and the books will be delivered to class. You can place your child's order at **scholastic.com.au/LOOP** or using the **LOOP** app, which can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play. The school no longer accepts payments using cash.
